This Circular Letter is to notify you that effective May 1, 2004, the Denver, Colorado, Regional Printing Plant was closed. The Denver Regional Printing Plant has experienced a steadily declining workload over the past several years and the decision to close the plant was made to stem the financial losses resulting from this decline.

The Denver Regional Printing Procurement Office (RPPO) will remain in operation and continue to serve GPO's customers located in the Denver area.
